BTW LESSON 10 CRUISING CENTRAL

OBJECTIVE: The objective of this lesson is to give the student, under supervision, the opportunity to put into practice all of the driving techniques they have previously learned. They must be knowledgeable of all traffic signs and signals.

DRIVING TIPS:

- 1. Never think one must do the maximum speed limit. In unfamiliar situations, one should do 5 to 10 mph under the posted speed limit.
- 2. Never speed up to make the light!
- 3. If you are at the point of no return, cover the brake and coast through the intersection.
- 4. Watch out for parked cars! They can be dangerous. If they are going to pull away from the curb, they may signal, their brake lights may be turned on and their back up lights may flash, as they shift gears.
- 5. *Keep your eyes moving! <u>Do not fix them on any one thing.</u> Two quick looks are better than one long one. (We do not need to add the numbers on the license plate.)*
- 6. Use maximum care and reduce your search pattern to 3 or 4 seconds. Keep those eyes moving!
- 7. Before entering an intersection, be sure that you can make it all the way across. Don't stop in the intersection.
