BTW LESSON 11 DIFFICULT INTERSECTIONS DOWNTOWN

Objective: In this lesson students will continue to practice their driving skills in a more complex environment. As they drive through down town they will be exploring some of the more interesting intersections in Great Falls.

Tips for Driving Down Town:

- 1. Aim high
- 2. Keep your eyes moving
- 3. Get the big picture.
- 4. Be sure others see you.
- 5. Leave yourself an out.
- 6. Think ahead to where you are going.
- 7. How will you get there?
- 8. Scan 1-2 blocks ahead.
- 9. Watch for drivers who may be pulling out from the curb, they don't always signal. Some may get out of their car without looking!
- 10. Never try to beat the light.
- 11. Reduce your visual search to about 3 seconds.
- 12. When entering an intersection, be sure you can pass all the way through.
- 13. If you must stop behind others, stop far enough back so you can see their tires touch the road surface.
- 14. Watch for "jay walkers", bikers, skate boarders and roller bladders.
- 15. Oh yes, drive carefully.
