BTW LESSON 12 THE TEST

Objective: To have every student capable and proficient in negotiating any and all streets and highways in and near Great Falls in a safe and legal manner.

Note: The test is given in two parts. One part is given for the Motor Vehicle Department, which is the same test given at the M.V.D. office. On this test one may have seven errors and still obtain a drivers license or a permit. The test for the completion of driver education is more comprehensive and also encompasses the test for the D.M.V. If the student scores 30 points or more, they will fail the driver education course. They will then have two choices: (1) re-take driver education or (2) wait until they are 16 and start over with the G.D.L. which means they will be 17 before they are fully licensed to drive.

Dangerous Acts: These are careless acts that if one is committed will fail the student for the D.M.V. and count 10 points each for driver education test.

- 1. Doesn't <u>signal & look</u> when pulling from the curb (mirror and head check)
- 2. Runs stop sign or red light
- 3. Lane change without looking (mirror and head check)
- 4. Makes a turn from the wrong lane (or tries to)
- 5. Forces evasive actions by others (swerve, brake, accelerate, etc)
- 6. Puts vehicle over the curb, sidewalk, and stop lines
- 7. Drives on the wrong side of the street (or tries to)
- 8. Drives the wrong way on a one way street. (or tries to)
- 9. Doesn't yield on left or right on red after stop
- 10. Confuses the brake and accelerator
- 11. Causes an accident
- 12. Flagrant violation of traffic signs, signals & laws
