Lesson 3

Backing and Turning

Objective: Your student will be able to do the following:

- 1. Successfully perform proper tracking while making left and right turns.
- 2. Use proper hand over hand steering while making said turns.
- 3. Be able to check left, right, left at uncontrolled intersections.
- 4. Properly stop in the correct position at stop signs and red lights
- 5. Properly check yield signs.
- 6. Properly back the vehicle left and right.
- 7. Park uphill with a curb.
- 8. Park downhill with a curb.

Parking: No parking within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection, within 30 feet of a traffic signal, stop or yield sign. No parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant. There is also no parking on the wrong side of the street. There is no parking where the curb is painted yellow. (As a reference the typical car is about 15 feet long).

Note: One must <u>always</u> signal when one changes direction, such as in a parking lot, making lane changes and 100 feet before turning at an intersection Also, one must stop when leaving an alley or parking lot. (<u>Get the habit</u>).
